

Act 12:1730.24

Act 12:1730.24 states, "Commercial and residential contractor may establish agreements with certified third-party providers to conduct plans review and inspections and enforce the state uniform construction code. A third-party provider shall be a Louisiana licensed architect or engineer or certified by the International Code Council for purposes of the emergency provisions of R.S. 40:1730.27. Thereafter, a third-party provider shall meet the requirements imposed by the council for certificates of registration. During the time period that the provisions of R.S. 40:1730.27 of this Part are in effect, every certified third-party provider doing business within the state shall notify the Department of Public Safety and Corrections of their intention to do business within the state and the department shall maintain a listing of the name of the provider and the name and location of the person or entity with whom the provider has contracted to provide enforcement services. Once the council meets for the first time, certified third-party providers shall notify the council of their intention to do business within the state and the council shall maintain a listing of all certified third-party providers."

Those persons wishing to notify the Department of Public Safety as being third-party providers shall provide this office with a written notification request. All such correspondence shall be addressed to Don Zeringue. Those legally qualifying parties shall be listed on this website.
