Re: Life Safety and Property Protection Board's Policy and Procedure Manual Licensing Section Memo 1-2011

Per R.S. 40:1664.11, the Life Safety and Property Protection (LSPP) Advisory Board is authorized to establish all initial certification and continuing education requirements for those firms and individuals seeking licensure to perform life safety and property protection contracting in the state. On November 16, 2010, the LSPP Advisory Board finalized its Policy and Procedure manual regarding initial certification and continuing education requirements. Included in this manual are new requirements for Qualifiers of firms. Requirements for Qualifiers will be phased in over the next three (3) years.

This document is a living document, thus it will be updated on a periodic basis as new courses are reviewed and approved by the Board.
