#### **Live Plan Review - August 26, 2014**

Watch as review architects do 'live reviews' of actual projects. See plans and schematics which have been submitted to the Office of State Fire Marshal for review/comment. NFPA, IBC, ADA-ABA and Fair Housing Issues will be pointed out and addressed.

David Jones graduated in Architecture in 1987 from Louisiana Tech University. He has been a licensed architect since 1992 and has worked in the field of architecture for 27 years. He has worked for the Louisiana State Fire Marshal's office in plan review for the past 8 years. He is a plan review architect /CBO performing life safety code/ building code plan reviews for contracted municipalities and parishes. For the past several years, he has conducted seminars within the Fire Marshal's Office and for the General Public to provide guidance in complying with NFPA 101/ IBC building code requirements.
