RE: CODE ADOPTION, July 1, 2010

Please refer to this office's website (LASFM.ORG) for the Fire Marshal Act and reference title 55 part V, Chapter 1, 103 for recently promulgated NFPA codes. These codes are promulgated every 3 years to take advantage of code editions which are published but not referenced directly by the NFPA 101 Life Safety Code. This serves the design construction industry by allowing these advanced code editions to be used for various appeals or other determinations, and for use in addressing hazards not referenced by NFPA 101. Administratively, this office adopts the 2010 Edition of the NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code for use due to its timely address of system monitoring concepts. Also worth noting, is the adoption of the 2009 Edition NFPA 1 as the State Fire Code and 2009 Edition NFPA 101 Life Safety Code.
